News following the AGM

We had a successful 2014 AGM in December, attended by 30 members..We followed the same format as 2013 when we used the Society's Projector to show some slides of last year's outing and also of one of our member's cruise around the North West coast of Australia which was very interesting. On a more serious note Robin Crouchman our Treasurer explained that he has been concerned that our costs are increasing, but our income is not. Therefore, there was a proposal on the Agenda it was proposed to increase, as from 1st March 2015, the Single Membership to £6.00 and for a Couple at the same address to £10.00. He also proposed that the member's entry fee for the Talks should be increased to £2.00 and non-members £3.00, this to take effect at the first meeting in October. Following discussion from the members these proposals were seconded and approved by meeting. It was also mentioned that 2019 would be the 200th Anniversary of the founding of the Society and it was agreed that we should start to think on ways that this could be celebrated. So if you have any ideas about this, please can you let one of the committee know.
