Remember, we have a special class for Novices (Class11) in the Rose Section, so if you have a rose which is nice and fresh, cut it and bring it along at 9 o'clock as a late entry! There are also classes for cookery and handicrafts, and I'm sure most of you have something that you could bring.

How to Enter: Email details of your entry to the Show Secretary (<u>liz.livermore@gmail.com</u>) no later than Wednesday 19th June, giving your name, address, phone number for contact and the number(s) of the class(es) you're entering. Late entries can be accepted up to 9.00am on the day of the show. You don't have to be a member to enter, and there are no entry fees, except for late entries received after Wednesday 19th for which a charge of 20p per exhibit is usually made. However, if you are a new exhibitor, even late entries will be free – yet another reason to have a go! Advance notice would be appreciated, though, especially if you have a large number of entries or bulky exhibits. On the morning of Saturday 22nd take your entry to Sewards End Village Hall between 9.00 and 11.00 am – there's plenty of room to park. Then come back at 2:15 to see if you won!

We could do with some more volunteers to help on Show Day, especially in the afternoon when we serve Tea and Cake to our visitors.
